AGREED FINAL JUDGMENT

The Court enters this Final Judgment in favor of Plaintiffs Ashish Patel, Anverali Satani, Nazira Momin, Minaz Chamadia, and Vijay Lakshmi Yogi and against Defendants Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation, its executive director, William H. Kuntz, Jr., in his official capacity, the Texas Commission on Licensing and Regulation, and its members, Mike Arismendez, Catherine Rodewald, Deborah Yurco, Ravi Shah, Thomas F. Butler, Helen Callier, and Rick Figueroa¹, in their official capacities (collectively, "State Defendants").

The Court's Judgment is based on two prior orders in this case:

1. The Agreed Order Granting Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment and Application for Permanent Injunction signed by the Honorable Gisela D. Triana on October 13, 2015.

2. The Order Partially Granting Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment on Attorney's Fees and Costs signed by the Honorable Amy Clark Meachum on August 5,

Both of the above orders are incorporated into this Judgment by this reference as though the terms of both orders had been fully set forth here.

IT IS ORDERED that the State Defendants shall pay Plaintiffs' counsel, the Institute for Justice, reasonable and necessary attorney's fees and costs in the amount of \$400,000.

IT IS ORDERED that this judgment shall accrue interest at the rate of five percent per year, as determined by the Texas Office of Consumer Credit Commissioner under Texas Finance Code Section 304.003, from the date of the Order Partially Granting Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment on Attorneys' Fees and Costs, August 5, 2016, until the date all amounts are paid in full by the State Defendants.

IT IS ORDERED that the parties' stipulation not to appeal this judgment is hereby accepted

This Judgment is final and appealable and disposes of all claims and all parties.
